## WHO WE ARE

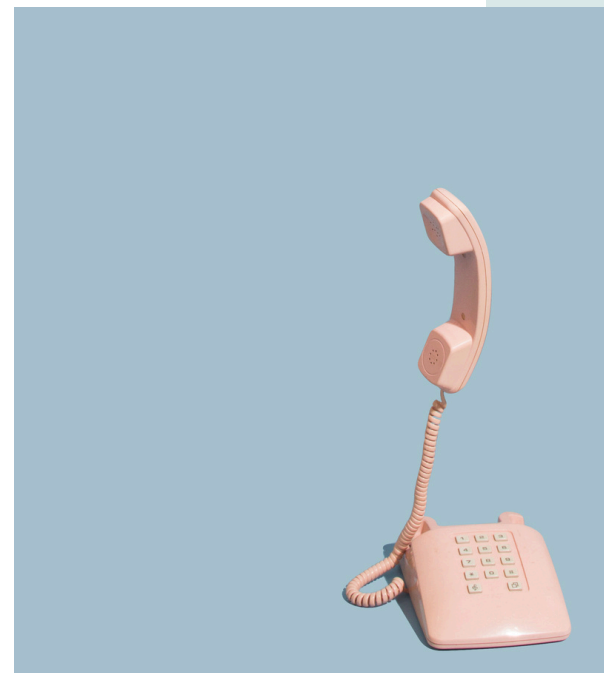
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DMI Psychology is an assessment and interventions clinic, offering psychological and positive behaviour support services to local communities.

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# WHAT TO EXPECT



## THE OPPORTUNITY

We are currently offering opportunities for student placements in psychology, social work or other relevant discipline. The aim of our placement offerings is to contribute to the professional development of a much needed workforce who have skills in clinical and positive approaches to mental health.

During the placement, students will gain hands-on experience in carrying out psychosocial assessments, case formulation, and intervention planning. Students will also learn how to use the positive behaviour support (PBS) framework to support people living with a disability.

Students will be clinically supervised by an AHPRA board approved psychologist clinical supervisor. At this time, DMI unfortunately does not have capacity to provide an AASW eligible clinical supervisor.

Students will be offered a range of learning experiences, including:

- Training program on PBS and clinical skills development
- Coaching and mentoring
- Diverse client exposure across the lifespan
- Develop and strengthen report writing skills
- Learning use of psychometric tools and frameworks for clinical assessments



# ABOUT YOU



## PLACEMENT SELECTION CRITERIA

### Essential:

- Tertiary qualifications in undergraduate psychology, social work or relevant allied health profession
- Demonstrated assessment or counselling experience
- Demonstrated written and oral communication skills
- Keen interest in working with people living with a disability, and psychosocial approaches to clinical practice
- Understanding of, and commitment to human rights issues
- Demonstrated ability to work independently and as part of a team
- Driver's license
- Access to vehicle with appropriate levels of insurance
- Placement must be a minimum of 200 hours
- Commitment to a minimum of 2-days per week

### Desirable:

- Currently completing a postgraduate degree in psychology, social work or other relevant discipline
- Experience working with people living with a disability, or on the NDIS
- Experience in working with children, adolescents and adults in a clinical setting
